A fee will be charged for the chaperone. Please be sure to enter the pool with your children and keep an eye on them always when they are in the pool.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Infants under 3 years old are not admitted. ※Even if the child is over 3 years old, he or she must be out of diapers.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> As a rule, up to 3 attendants per disabled person will be admitted free of charge to (If the number of attendants exceeds 4, please consult with the receptionist.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Swimsuits must be worn in the pool area, including by chaperones.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Wearing a T-shirt or similar is permitted. No entry into the pool</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Beach balls may not be used in times of congestion.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Glasses and sunglasses should be removed when entering the pools. Only those who lose their eyesight significantly when taken off glasses bands</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> The pool cannot be used in conjunction with the children's pool or indoor pool</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Children in grades 3 to 6 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian if they are using the pool after 18:30</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Picnic sheets, etc, measuring 2m long and 1m wide, may be laid out only in designated areas. Please fold them up when leaving the area.</li> </ul>			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Children aged 3rd grade or above are not permitted to use the children's pool.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Children in the second grade of elementary school or younger must be accompanied by a junior high school student or older.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Each attendant is limited to two children.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Please refrain from dangerous activities such as diving, running on the pool side, or using the slide.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> We ask that accompanying parents not take their eyes off children.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> The pool cannot be used in conjunction with the 50m pool or indoor pool.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Children who are still in diapers must wear a swimming diaper under their swimsuit.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Children are not permitted to enter the water wearing only a swimming diaper.</li> </ul>		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Eating is not permitted within the facility, including by the pool or in the changing rooms.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Photography is not permitted inside or outside the venue.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Please refrain from diving, submerging, doing handstands, or other dangerous activities.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Please refrain from using mobile phones in the changing rooms.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> You cannot enter the pool area wearing footwear.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Please remove any jewelry to prevent injury.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> To prevent theft, please store your valuables in the valuables box at the front desk.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Parking is available for 300 yen for 20 minutes. (Please use public transportation as the number of parking spaces is limited.)</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> The last admission to each pool is 30 minutes before closing.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Shampoo, conditioner, soap, etc. cannot be used.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Please note that the event may be postponed or canceled</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> This is a public pool, so please refrain from any behavior that may cause inconvenience to other users.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Please share the use of the pool and rental equipment with other guests (equipment is limited in number).</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Anyone under the influence of alcohol will be denied entry.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> The pool may not be used for commercial instruction.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> In accordance with the Meguro Ward Public Baths Law Enforcement Ordinance,</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Lockers in the changing rooms cost 100 yen and are returnable.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Please follow other instructions from gymnasium and pool staff.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Floats or floats over 1m40cm</li><li>• Bodyboard, paddle, snorkel, etc.</li><li>• Wetsuits, beach sandals, etc.</li><li>• Cameras, video cameras, mobile phones, smartphones</li><li>• Electronic equipment, etc. Writing utensils, etc.</li><li>• Tents and other items that occupy space <small>(Picnic blankets up to 2 meters long and 1 meter wide are permitted)</small></li><li>• Card games, board games, Straw hat etc.</li><li>• Beverages in containers without lids, beverages in containers with lids that come off easily, alcoholic of beverages.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• accessories (pierce, necklace, earrings, etc.) <small>(Including medical magnetic necklaces and sports necklaces)</small></li><li>• Newspapers, etc. <small>(advertisements that may be blown away by the wind, etc.)</small></li><li>• Food (including gum, candy, and jelly)</li><li>• Glass items such as bottles</li><li>• parasol</li><li>• Sun oil/sunscreen: The following conditions apply <small>(If you have weak or sensitive skin, waterproof and fragrance-free products are acceptable.)</small></li><li>• Ball <small>(vinyl inflatable balls with a diameter of less than 100 cm are acceptable)</small></li><li>• Water balloons, water guns</li></ul>

※Please note that even items not listed as prohibited may be asked to be removed if staff deem them dangerous based on how they are being used or the level of crowding.

### Rules for using smartwatches

- The only permitted use is for the healthcare function.
- Only smartwatches with a strap made of silicone or rubber can be used.
- Please wear a protective band (made of silicone, rubber, or cushioned cloth) over your smartwatch.

Those with visible tattoos will be denied entry to the community pool.

As of July 1, 2013, people with exposed tattoos will not be allowed to enter the municipal swimming pool. Please be sure to wear a rash guard or similar clothing when entering the venue. We ask for your understanding and cooperation so that we can alleviate any anxiety felt by other users and children and allow them to enjoy swimming comfortably. As a general rule, we ask that you bring your own rash guards etc. We also offer rentals, but the number is limited.

\*The event may be canceled due to weather conditions, etc.

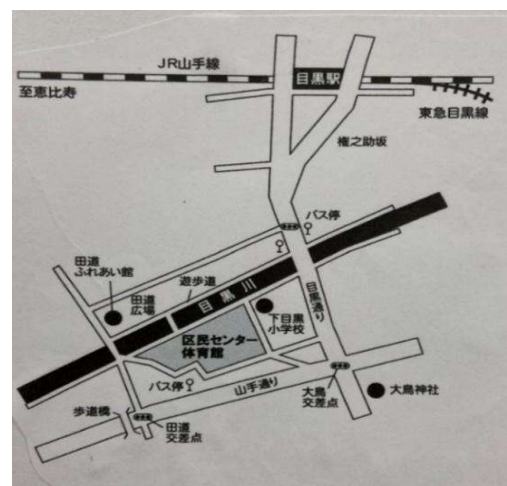
